Cause

This behaviour is by default.

Resolution

Use the following procedure:

- Click on the Start button
- In the search bar, type *cmd* and press enter (a command prompt opens)
- Type *powercfg.cpl,1* and press enter (the Power Options panel opens)
- Scroll down to "Power buttons and lid" and expand it
- Expand "Start menu power button"
- Change the setting from "Sleep" to "Shut down"
- Click on "OK" to confirm the configuration change
- Close the command prompt
